## FINAL JUDGMENT

This Final Judgment is entered pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 58(a) and in

accordance with the Order Reversing Disability Decision and Remanding to

Commissioner [#23] entered by Judge Robert E. Blackburn on March 13, 2014, which

order is incorporated herein by this reference.

## THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the conclusion of the Commissioner through the Administrative Law

Judge that plaintiff was not disabled is **REVERSED**;

2. That this case is **REMANDED** to the ALJ, who is directed to:

a. Order a consultative examination to provide evidence relevant to a proper determination of plaintiff's mental residual functional capacity;

b. Recontact any treating or examining source, seek the testimony of medical experts, solicit further vocational expert testimony, or otherwise further develop the record as she deems necessary;

- c. Reevaluate plaintiff's mental residual functional capacity; and
- d. Reassess the disability determination; and
- 3. That plaintiff is **AWARDED** her costs, to be taxed by the clerk of the court

pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(d)(1), D.C.COLO.LCivR 54.1, and 28 U.S.C. § 2412(a)(1).
