ORDERED that **within thirty (30) days from the date of this order** the Respondents shall file with the Clerk of the Court, in electronic format if available, a copy of the complete record in *People v. Longoria*, Denver District Court Case Nos. 04CR4688, 03CR3737, and 04CR1661, including all documents in the state court file and transcripts of all proceedings conducted in the state court, but excluding any physical evidence (as opposed to documentary evidence) not relevant to the asserted claims. FURTHER ORDERED that the record, if provided in electronic format, shall display transcripts for all proceedings, including hearings and days of trial, by separate date and not as one continuous document. It is
