**ORDER DISMISSING DEFENDANT, OLD REPUBLIC INSURANCE COMPANY,
ONLY**

Blackburn, J.

The matter is before the court on the **Stipulation of Dismissal Between Plaintiffs and Defendant ORIC Only** [#142]¹ and the **Notice That ORIC is No Longer a Party** [#142-1] both filed September 2, 2014. After reviewing the stipulation, notice, and the record, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that plaintiffs' claims against defendant, Old Republic Insurance Company, should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the **Stipulation of Dismissal Between Plaintiffs and Defendant ORIC Only** [#142] filed September 2, 2014, is **APPROVED**;

2. That plaintiffs' claims against defendant, Old Republic Insurance Company, are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**; and

3. That defendant, Old Republic Insurance Company, is **DROPPED** as a named party to this litigation, and the case caption is amended accordingly.
