## FINAL JUDGMENT

This **Final Judgment** is entered pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 58(a) and in accordance with the **Order Reversing Disability Decision and Remanding to Commissioner** [#17] entered by Judge Robert E. Blackburn on March 20, 2014, which order is incorporated herein by this reference.

## THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

- That the conclusion of the Commissioner through the Administrative Law
   Judge that plaintiff was not disabled is REVERSED;
- 2. That this case is **REMANDED** to the ALJ, who is directed to:
  - a. Solicit further vocational expert testimony or otherwise further develop the record as he deems necessary to substantiate a determination as to whether there are other jobs in the local and national economies that are within plaintiff's residual functional capacity as previously assessed;
  - b. Reassess his determination at step 5 of the sequential evaluation; and

- c. Reassess the disability determination; and
- 3. That plaintiff is **AWARDED** his costs, to be taxed by the clerk of the court pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(d)(1), D.C.COLO.LCivR 54.1, and 28 U.S.C. § 2412(a)(1). DATED at Denver, Colorado, this 21<sup>st</sup> day of March, 2014.
