ORDER

Blackburn, J.

The matter before me is the parties' joint **Motion for Order Approving Stipulation of Award of Attorney Fees and Expenses Under the Equal Access to Justice Act** [#20],¹ filed December 8, 2014. Based on the parties stipulation and the record, I find and conclude that the motion is well-taken and should be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the parties' joint **Motion for Order Approving Stipulation of Award of Attorney Fees and Expenses Under the Equal Access to Justice Act** [#20], filed December 8, 2014, is **GRANTED**; and
2. That under the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d)(1)(A), plaintiff is **AWARDED** attorney fees of \$5,230.00 and expenses.
