**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

The matter is before me on the **Stipulation For Dismissal With Prejudice** [#21]<sup>1</sup> filed October 14, 2013. After reviewing the stipulation and the record, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved, and that this action should be dismissed with prejudice with each party to pay their own attorneys' fees and costs.

2. That the Final Pretrial Conference and Trial Preparation Conference set for April 25, 2014, are **VACATED**;
3. That the jury trial set to commence May 12, 2014, is **VACATED**; and


