## ENTERED BY MAGISTRATE JUDGE KRISTEN L. MIX

This matter is before the Court on Plaintiff's **Unopposed Motion to Amend Scheduling Order** [#69]<sup>1</sup> (the "Motion"). On April 25, 2014, the Court extended the Discovery Cut-Off to June 13, 2014, for the limited purpose of allowing the parties to depose Debra Delk. *Minute Order* [#68] at 1. In the Motion, Plaintiff asks that the parties be allowed to depose Defendant Dr. Jasjot Johar within the extended Discovery Cut-Off period. *Id.* at 1, 3.

IT IS HEREBY **ORDERED** that the Motion [#69] is **GRANTED**. The Scheduling Order entered on October 15, 2013 [#45], and amended on February 13, 2014 [#65] and April 25, 2014 [#68], is further modified to extend the Discovery Cut-Off to **June 13, 2014**, for the limited purpose of deposing two individuals: Debra Delk and Defendant Dr. Jasjot Johar.
