## **ORDER**

The parties are directed to review the Appendix to Gillard v. Boulder Valley School Dist., 196 F.R.D. 382 (D. Colo. 2000), and to submit a blanket protective order more in line with that.

IT IS ORDERED that the Motion [Doc. # 22] is DENIED without prejudice.
