**Blackburn, J.**

The matter before me is the parties' **Stipulation to Attorney Fees Under the Equal Access to Justice Act** [#26],<sup>1</sup> filed January 7, 2015. Based on the parties' stipulation, and having otherwise adequately been informed of the premises, I find and conclude that the stipulation is appropriate and should be approved.

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** as follows:


