This matter is before the Court on **Defendant's Unopposed Motion For Leave to file Its first Amended Answer and Defenses** [#56]¹ (the "Motion"). As an initial matter, the Motion does not comply with D.C.COLO.LCivR 15.1(a), which requires, that "[a] party who files an amended pleading under Fed. R. Civ. P. 15(a)(1) or with the consent of the opposing party shall file a separate notice of filing the amended pleading and shall attach as an exhibit a copy of the amended pleading which strikes through . . . the text to be deleted and underlines . . . the text to be added."
