ORDER

Blackburn, J.

The matter is before the court on the defendant's **Motion For Order Approving Stipulation of Award of Attorney Fees Under The Equal Access to Justice Act** [#22]¹ filed October 6, 2014. After reviewing the motion and the record, I conclude that the motion should be granted and that the plaintiff should pay reasonable attorney fees in the amount of \$4,491.28.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:


