ORDER DIRECTING PLAINTIFF TO CURE DEFICIENCIES

However, Plaintiff fails to cite any authority that would allow the court to consider the motion to appoint counsel before he files a proper pleading. Therefore, this civil action has been commenced. As part of the court's review pursuant to D.C.COLO.LCivR 8.2, the court has determined that the motion is deficient as described in this order. Plaintiff will be directed to cure the following if he wishes to pursue any claims in this action. Any papers that Plaintiff files in response to this order must

include the civil action number on this order.
