**ORDER DISMISSING KENNETH CARPENTER**

The matter is before the court on the **Unopposed Motion To Dismiss Kenneth Carpenter Claims With Prejudice** [#116]<sup>1</sup> filed September 30, 2014. After reviewing the motion and the record, the court has concluded that the motion should be granted and the claims of plaintiff, Kenneth Carpenter, against defendant, American Family Mutual Insurance Company, should be dismissed with prejudice.

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** as follows:

1. That **Unopposed Motion To Dismiss Kenneth Carpenter Claims With Prejudice** [#116] filed September 30, 2014, is **GRANTED**;
2. That the claims of plaintiff, Kenneth Carpenter, against defendant, American Family Mutual Insurance Company, are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**, with each of


