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**ORDER OF DISMISSAL TO THE  
OCTOBER 30, 2012 CLAIM, ONLY**

The matter is before the court on the **Stipulated Motion To Dismiss The October 30, 2012 Claim Without Prejudice** [#82]<sup>1</sup> filed June 13, 2014. After reviewing the motion and the record, I conclude that the motion should be granted and that plaintiff's "October 30, 2012" claim against the defendant should be dismissed without prejudice.

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** as follows:

1. That the **Stipulated Motion To Dismiss The October 30, 2012 Claim Without Prejudice** [#82] filed June 13, 2014, is **GRANTED**;

2. That plaintiff's "October 30, 2012" claim against the defendant is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE** with the parties to pay their own attorney fees and costs that
