Caler. It is further

ORDERED that defendants are **AWARDED** their costs, to be taxed by the Clerk of the Court pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 54(d)(1) and D.C.COLO.LCivR 54.1. It is further

ORDERED that this case is **CLOSED**.
