**ORDER OF DISMISSAL AS TO DEFFENDANT
CANDENT CONSTRUCTION, LLC, ONLY**

The matter is before me on the **Stipulated Motion For Dismissal of Defendant Candent Construction, LLC** [#15]¹ filed November 4, 2013. After reviewing the motion and the record, I conclude that the motion should be granted and that plaintiff's claims against defendant, Candent Construction, LLC, should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the **Stipulated Motion For Dismissal of Defendant Candent Construction, LLC** [#15] filed November 4, 2013, is **GRANTED**;
2. That plaintiff's claims against defendant, Candent Construction, LLC, are **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**; and

3. That defendant, Candent Construction, LLC, is **DROPPED** as a named defendant in this action, and the case caption is amended accordingly.
