**ORDER OF DISMISSAL AS TO DEFENDANTS,
OXBOW CARBON LLC, OXBOW CARBON & MINERALS LLC, AND
OXBOW CARBON & MINERALS INTERNATIONAL GmbH, ONLY**

Blackburn, J.

The matter is before me on the **Stipulated Motion For Dismissal With Prejudice of Defendants Oxbow Carbon LLC, Oxbow Carbon & Minerals, LLC, Oxbow Carbon & Minerals International GmbH** [#107]¹ filed March 31, 2014. After reviewing the notice and the record, I conclude that the notice should be approved and that plaintiff's claims against defendants, Oxbow Carbon LLC, Oxbow Carbon & Minerals LLC, and Oxbow Carbon & Minerals International GmbH, should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the **Stipulated Motion For Dismissal With Prejudice of Defendants Oxbow Carbon LLC, Oxbow Carbon & Minerals, LLC, Oxbow Carbon & Minerals International GmbH** [#107] filed March 31, 2014, is **GRANTED**;
2. That plaintiff's claims against defendants, Oxbow Carbon LLC, Oxbow Carbon & Minerals, LLC, and Oxbow Carbon & Minerals International GmbH, are **DISMISSED PREJUDICE**; and
3. That defendants, Oxbow Carbon LLC, Oxbow Carbon & Minerals, LLC, and Oxbow Carbon & Minerals International GmbH, are **DROPPED** as named parties to this litigation, and the case caption is amended accordingly.
