APPOINTMENT ORDER

In accordance with Part III.C. of the U.S. District Court's *Pilot Program to Implement A Civil Pro Bono Panel*, the Court hereby determines that Plaintiff Michael Bacote Jr. merits appointment of counsel drawn from the Civil Pro Bono Panel.
