ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Blackburn, J.

The matter is before the court on the **Stipulation For Dismissal With Prejudice** [#63]¹ filed July 1, 2014. After reviewing the stipulation and the record, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that this action should be dismissed with prejudice.

1. That the **Stipulation For Dismissal With Prejudice** [#63] filed July 1, 2014, is **APPROVED**;
2. That the combined Final Pretrial Conference and the Trial Preparation Conference set November 14, 2014, are **VACATED**;
3. That the trial to the court set to commence November 17, 2014, is **VACATED**;

4. That any pending motion is **DENIED** as moot; and
