**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

The matter is before the court on the **Stipulated Dismissal of Entire Action, Including All Claims and Counterclaims, With Prejudice** [#28]<sup>1</sup> filed September 25, 2014. After reviewing the stipulation and the record, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that this action should be dismissed with prejudice.

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** as follows:

1. That the **Stipulated Dismissal of Entire Action, Including All Claims and Counterclaims, With Prejudice** [#28] filed September 25, 2014, is **APPROVED**;
2. That the combined Final Pretrial Conference and Trial Preparation Conference set March 20, 2015, are **VACATED**;

3. That the jury trial set to commence April 6, 2015, is **VACATED**;
4. That any pending motion is **DENIED** as moot; and
5. That this action is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE** with the parties to pay their own attorney fees and costs.
