**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

The matter is before me on the **Stipulated Motion To Dismiss Peter Janes, M.D., Kathryn Reaney, PA-C, and Vail-Summit Orthopaedics, P.C. with Prejudice** [#94]<sup>1</sup> filed August 4, 2015. After careful review of the stipulated motion and the file, I conclude that the motion should be granted and that the claims of the plaintiff against defendants, Peter Janes, M.D., Kathryn Reaney, PA-C, and Vail-Summit Orthopaedics, P.C., should be dismissed with prejudice.

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** as follows:

1. That the **Stipulated Motion To Dismiss Peter Janes, M.D., Kathryn Reaney, PA-C, and Vail-Summit Orthopaedics, P.C. with Prejudice** is granted;
2. That the claims of the plaintiff against defendants, Peter Janes, M.D., Kathryn


