**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

The matter is before me on the **Stipulation of Dismissal With Prejudice** [#33],<sup>1</sup> filed January 30, 2015. 3. That the telephonic motions setting hearing conference scheduled for **February 18, 2015, at 10:00 a.m.**, is **VACATED**; and


