**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

The matter is before me on the **Stipulation for Dismissal with Prejudice** [#53]<sup>1</sup> filed May 20, 2015. After careful review of the stipulation and the file, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that this action should be dismissed with prejudice.
