**ORDER OF DISMISSAL AS TO
DEFENDANT, ROY ECKERT, ONLY**

The matter is before the court on the **Notice of Dismissal Without Prejudice as to Defendant Roy Eckert Pursuant to F.R.C.P. 41 or, in The Alternative, F.R.C.P. 15** [#30]¹ filed September 11, 2014. After reviewing the notice and the record, the court has concluded that the notice should be approved, and that plaintiff's claims against defendant, Roy Eckert, should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the **Notice of Dismissal Without Prejudice as to Defendant Roy Eckert Pursuant to F.R.C.P. 41 or, in The Alternative, F.R.C.P. 15** [#30] filed

September 11, 2014, is **APPROVED**;

2. That plaintiff's claims defendant, Roy Eckert, are **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**; and

3. That defendant, Roy Eckert, is **DROPPED** as a named party to this action, and the case caption is amended accordingly.
