**ORDER FOR AWARD OF EAJA FEES**

Kane, J.

The Stipulation re Attorney submitted by the parties under the Equal Access to Justice Act (Doc. 25), dated February 10, 2015, is **APPROVED**. In consideration thereof, it is

**ORDERED** that the Defendant shall pay to Plaintiff , through counsel, reasonable attorney fees and expenses in the amount of **\$4,700**. As stipulated, the EAJA award is without prejudice to Plaintiff's attorney's right to seek fees under § 206(b) of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. § 406(b), subject to EAJA's offset provisions. *See* 28 U.S.C. § 2412(c)(1) (2006).
