This matter is before the Court on **Defendant's Renewed, Unopposed Motion to Amend Scheduling Order to Extend Discovery Cutoff for Sole Purpose of Completing Certain Depositions on April 30<sup>th</sup> and May 1<sup>st</sup> [#37]**<sup>1</sup> (the "Motion").

IT IS HEREBY **ORDERED** that the Motion [#37] is **GRANTED**. Accordingly,

IT IS FURTHER **ORDERED** that the Civil Scheduling Order entered on September 10, 2014 [#21] and supplemented on September 16, 2014 [#22], is amended to extend the **Discovery Cut-Off to May 1, 2015** for the sole purpose of allowing the parties to complete the following depositions: (1) the Fed. R. Civ. P. 30(b)(6) deposition of Plaintiff's public adjusting company; (2) the Fed. R. Civ. P. 30(b)(6) deposition of Plaintiff's roofing contractor; (3) and the Fed. R. Civ. P. 30(b)(6) deposition of Plaintiff.
