ORDER OF DISMISSAL



4. That the combined Final Pretrial Conference and Trial Preparation Conference set **May 8, 2015**, at **10:00 a.m.**, and the jury trial set to commence **June 8, 2015**, are **VACATED**; and

5. That this action is **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**, with the parties to pay their own attorney fees and costs.
