ORDER DISMISSING PARTIES

Blackburn, J.

The matter is before me on the plaintiff's **Motion To Dismiss Jason Schuh and Stacie Schuh Contingent on Them Not Being Designated as Non-Parties at Fault** [#71]¹ filed August 19, 2015. After careful review of the motion and the file, I conclude that the motion should be granted and that the claims of plaintiff against defendants, Jason Schuh and Stacie Schuh, should be dismissed without prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the **Motion To Dismiss Jason Schuh and Stacie Schuh Contingent on Them Not Being Designated as Non-Parties at Fault** is granted;
2. That the claims of plaintiff against defendants, Jason Schuh and Stacie Schuh,

are dismissed without prejudice; and
