ORDER DIRECTING PLAINTIFF TO CURE DEFICIENCIES

Complaint or Petition:

- (9) is not submitted
- (10) is not on proper form (must use the Court's current form)
- (11) is missing an original signature by Plaintiff
- (12) is incomplete
- (13) uses et al. instead of listing all parties in caption
- (14) names in caption do not match names in text
- (15) addresses must be provided for all defendants/respondents in "Section A. Parties" of complaint, petition or habeas application

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that Plaintiff cure the deficiencies designated above **within thirty days from the date of this Order**. Any papers that Plaintiff files in response to this Order must include the civil action number on this Order. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff shall obtain the Court-approved forms used in filing an Application to Proceed in District Court Without Prepaying Fees or Costs and a Complaint, along with the applicable instructions, at www.cod.uscourts.gov. Plaintiff must use Court-approved forms to cure deficiencies. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that if Plaintiff fails to cure the designated deficiencies **within thirty days from the date of this Order** the action will be dismissed without further notice.
