MINUTE ORDER

ORDER ENTERED BY MAGISTRATE JUDGE BOYD N. BOLAND

Plaintiff's "Motion to Dismiss (Drop) the Attorney General of the State of Colorado as a Defendant and Add the Colorado Dept. of Corrections as a Defendant" (ECF No. 4) is DENIED as unnecessary.
