Defendant's Unopposed Motion for Remand (ECF No. 28), seeking entry of judgment and a remand for further administrative proceedings under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), is **GRANTED**. The final decision of the agency is **REVERSED** and the case **REMANDED** for further administrative proceedings pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g). On remand, the Appeals Council will instruct the ALJ to exhibit and consider the evidence not exhibited, consider the new evidence, and issue a decision.

The Clerk is directed to enter a judgment in accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 58, consistent with the United States Supreme Court's decision in *Shalala v. Schaefer*, 509 U.S. 292, 296-302 (1993).
