ORDER DIRECTING APPLICANT TO CURE DEFICIENCY

Applicant, Dean Raymond Garcia, initiated this action by filing, *pro se*, an Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241 and paying the \$5.00 filing fee. As part of the Court's review pursuant to D.C.COLO.LCivR 8.1(b), the Court has determined that the submitted documents are deficient as described in this Order. Applicant will be directed to cure the following if he wishes to pursue his claims. Any papers that Applicant files in response to this Order must include the civil action number on this Order.

28 U.S.C. § 1915 Motion and Affidavit:

- (1) is not submitted
- (2) is missing affidavit
- (3) is missing a certified prisoner's trust fund statement showing Applicant's current balance in his account
- (4) the account statement showing the current balance in Applicant's prison account is not certified
- (5) is missing required financial information
- (6) is missing an original signature by the prisoner
- (7) is not on proper form (must use the Court's current form)

- (8) names in caption do not match names in caption of complaint, petition or habeas application
- (9) An original and a copy have not been received by the court.
Only an original has been received.
- (10) other:

Complaint, Petition or Application:

- (11) is not submitted
- (12) is not on proper form (must use the Court's current form)
- (13) is missing an original signature by the prisoner
- (14) is missing page nos.
- (15) uses et al. instead of listing all parties in caption
- (16) An original and a copy have not been received by the court. Only an original has been received.
- (17) Sufficient copies to serve each defendant/respondent have not been received by the court.
- (18) names in caption do not match names in text
- (19) other:

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that Applicant cure the deficiency designated above **within thirty days from the date of this Order**. Any papers that Applicant files in response to this Order must include the civil action number on this Order. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall obtain the Court-approved forms used in filing an Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241 (with the assistance of his case manager or the facility's legal assistant), along with the applicable instructions, at www.cod.uscourts.gov. Applicant must use a Court-approved form to cure the deficiency. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that if Applicant fails to cure the designated deficiency **within thirty days from the date of this Order** the action will be dismissed without further notice.
