ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Blackburn, J.

The matter is before me on the **Stipulation of Dismissal With Prejudice** [#13]¹ filed December 10, 2014. After reviewing the stipulation and the record, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that this action should be dismissed with prejudice with the parties to pay their own attorney fees and costs.

3. That all pending motions, including but not limited to **Defendant's Motion To Dismiss Pursuant to CRCP 12(b)(5)** [#1-10], filed August 29, 2014, are **DENIED AS**
