MINUTE ORDER

ORDER ENTERED BY MAGISTRATE JUDGE GORDON P. GALLAGHER

Plaintiff's motions for appointment of counsel (ECF No. 24) and to produce records/data compilations (ECF No. 25) are DENIED as premature.
