Plaintiff's counsel may appear by telephone at the Scheduling Conference on May 13, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. by dialing the Court at **303-335-2770**. If any other parties are granted leave to appear telephonically, these parties must initiate a conference call between themselves and Plaintiff's counsel before dialing the Court.
