ORDER DISMISSING A PARTY

The matter is before me on the **Stipulation for Dismissal with Prejudice** [#28],¹ filed May 4, 2015. After careful review of the stipulation and the file, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that the plaintiff's claims against defendant, Twin City Fire Insurance Company, d/b/a The Hartford, should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:


1. That the **Stipulation for Dismissal with Prejudice** [#28], filed May 4, 2015, is approved;
