**ORDER OF DISMISSAL AS TO
DEFENDANT, SIERRA VISTA ELECTRIC, ONLY**

The matter is before the court on the **Stipulated Motion to Dismiss Defendant Sierra Vista** [#23]¹ filed December 19, 2014. After reviewing the motion and the record, the court concludes that the motion should be granted and that the claims of the plaintiffs against the defendant, Sierra Vista Electric, should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That **Stipulated Motion to Dismiss Defendant Sierra Vista** [#23] filed December 19, 2014, is **GRANTED**; and

2. That the claims of the plaintiffs against defendant, Sierra Vista Electric, are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**; and
3. That defendant, Sierra Vista Electric, is **DROPPED** as a named party to this action, and the case caption is amended accordingly.
