ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter is before the court on the Parties' Stipulated Motion to Dismiss with Prejudice with Court's Retention of Jurisdiction to Enforce Settlement ("Stipulated Motion to Dismiss") [#32, filed February 4, 2016] pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(c), the Order of Reference for all purposes dated August 19, 2015 [#26].
