**ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION TO HOLD
CASE IN ABEYANCE PENDING SETTLEMENT NEGOTIATIONS**

Blackburn, J.

The matter before me is the **Unopposed Motion by Plaintiffs To Hold Case in Abeyance Pending Settlement Negotiations** [#9],¹ filed January 23, 2015. Having considered the motion and the relevant record, I agree that a brief stay to allow the parties to pursue alternate dispute resolution would promote the aims of Fed. R. Civ. P. 1 “to secure the just, speedy, and inexpensive determination of every action and proceeding.”

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the **Unopposed Motion by Plaintiffs To Hold Case in Abeyance Pending Settlement Negotiations** [#9], filed January 23, 2015, is **GRANTED**;
2. That this matter is **STAYED** until March 9, 2015; and

3. That by March 16, 2015, plaintiffs **SHALL FILE** a notice of dismissal or, alternatively, a status report apprising the court of the status of the case.
