## MINUTE ORDER

This matter comes before the court on the Parties' Joint Motion to Amend the Scheduling Order [#48] which was referred to this Magistrate Judge pursuant to the Order of Reference dated January 27, 2015 [#13] and the Memorandum dated August 17, 2014 [#49].
