ORDER DIRECTING APPLICANT TO CURE DEFICIENCIES

Applicant Jennifer M. Stickler appears to reside in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

Applicant initiated this action by filing *pro se* an Application for a Writ of Habeas Corpus Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254.

As part of the Court's review pursuant to D.C.COLO.LCivR 8.1(a) and (b), the Court has determined that the submitted document is deficient as described in this Order. Applicant will be directed to cure the following if he wishes to pursue his claims. Any papers that Applicant files in response to this Order must include the civil action number on this Order.

**Motion and Affidavit for Leave to Proceed Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915/
Application to Proceed in District Court Without Prepayment of Costs and Fees :**

- (1) is not submitted
- (2) is not on proper form (must use the proper Court-approved form)
- (3) is missing original signature by Applicant
- (4) is missing affidavit
- (5) affidavit is incomplete
- (6) affidavit is not properly notarized

- (7) names in caption do not match names in caption of complaint, petition or application
- (8) other: **If Applicant is not incarcerated must use Application to Proceed in District Court Without Prepayment of Costs and Fees. If incarcerated must provide a current certified trust fund account statement.**

Complaint or Petition:

- (9) is not submitted
- (10) is not on proper form (must use Court-approved form)
- (11) is missing an original signature by the Applicant
- (12) is incomplete
- (13) uses et al. instead of listing all parties in caption
- (14) names in caption do not match names in text of Complaint
- (15) addresses must be provided for all defendants/respondents in "Section A. Parties" of complaint, petition or habeas application
- (16) other:.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that Applicant cure the deficiencies designated above **within thirty days from the date of this Order**. Any papers that Applicant files in response to this Order must include the civil action number on this Order. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall obtain the Court-approved forms noted above at www.cod.uscourts.gov, (if incarcerated with the assistance of her case manager or the facility's legal assistant), along with the applicable instructions. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that if Applicant fails to cure the designated deficiencies **within thirty days from the date of this Order** the action will be dismissed without further notice.
