ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO STAY

Blackburn, J.

The matter before me is **Defendants Asus Computer International and AsusTek Computer, Inc.’s Motion To Stay Pending Resolution of Their Rule 12(b)(1) Motion** [#33],¹ filed August 11, 2015. Having the approval of the magistrate judge, I withdraw the prior order of reference of this motion ([#34], filed August 12, 2015), grant the motion, and stay further all discovery in this matter.² The stay shall not apply to completion of briefing on **Defendants Asus Computer International and AsusTek Computer, Inc.’s Motion To Dismiss for Lack of Standing** [#32], filed August 11, 2015, or that required by the court’s **Order Concerning Appointment of**

Special Master [#43], filed August 17, 2015.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the order of reference ([#34], filed August 12, 2015) is withdrawn;
2. That **Defendants Asus Computer International and AsusTek Computer, Inc.'s Motion To Stay Pending Resolution of Their Rule 12(b)(1) Motion** [#33], filed August 11, 2015, is granted; and
3. That this action is stayed, except as to the briefing on **Defendants Asus Computer International and AsusTek Computer, Inc.'s Motion To Dismiss for Lack of Standing** [#32], filed August 11, 2015, and the court's **Order Concerning Appointment of Special Master** [#43], filed August 17, 2015.
