ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Blackburn, J.

The matter is before me on the **Stipulation for Dismissal with Prejudice** [#30]¹ filed March 22, 2016. After careful review of the stipulation and the file, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that this case should be dismissed with prejudice.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the **Stipulation for Dismissal with Prejudice** is approved;
2. That all pending pretrial deadlines are vacated;
3. That the combined Final Pretrial Conference/Trial Preparation Conference set May 20, 2016, is vacated;
4. That the jury trial set to commence June 13, 2016, is vacated; and
5. That this case is dismissed with prejudice with the parties to pay their own attorney fees and costs.
