**ORDER GRANTING STIPULATED MOTION FOR ATTORNEY
FEES UNDER THE EQUAL ACCESS TO JUSTICE ACT**

Blackburn, J.

The matter before me is plaintiff's **EAJA Motion for Award of Attorney's Fees**¹ [#23],² filed November 19, 2015. By her response [#24], filed November 25, 2015, the Commissioner indicates that she has no objection to the amount of fees and expenses requested. I therefore grant the motion and award that amount of fees payable to plaintiff. *See Manning v. Astrue*, 510 F.3d 1246, 1249-55 (10th Cir. 2007), *cert. denied*, 129 S.Ct. 486 (2008).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That plaintiff's **EAJA Motion for Award of Attorney's Fees** [#23], filed November 19, 2015, is granted; and

2. That pursuant to the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d)(1)(A), plaintiff is awarded attorney fees of \$4,025.15.
