**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

The matter is before me on the **Joint Stipulation of Dismissal Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41** [#27],<sup>1</sup> filed March 11, 2016. After careful review of the stipulation and the file, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that this action should be dismissed with prejudice.

**THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** as follows:

1. That the **Joint Stipulation of Dismissal Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 41** [#27], filed March 11, 2016, is approved;
2. That all pending pretrial deadlines are vacated;
3. That the combined Final Pretrial Conference/Trial Preparation Conference set July 22, 2016, is vacated;
4. That the jury trial set to commence August 1, 2016, is vacated; and


