MINUTE ORDER

This matter is before the Court on the parties' **Joint, But Disputed, Motion for Entry of Protective Order** [#34]¹ (the "Motion"). In the Motion, the parties jointly seek entry of a protective order. However, there is a dispute with regard to inclusion of two paragraphs in the tendered Protective Order. *Motion* [#34] at 2. In the Motion, the parties provide the Court with their positions regarding the disputed paragraphs. *Id.* at 2-9. The Court has reviewed the parties' positions and resolves the dispute through the interlineations included in the version of the Protective Order entered by the Court.
