**ORDER APPROVING STIPULATION RE: AGREED VENUE

The matter before me is the parties' **Stipulation Re: Agreed Venue of the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York** [#39],¹ filed December 14, 2015. This stipulation comes in response my **Order Granting Defendant's Motion To Transfer Venue** [#38], filed November 19, 2015. (*See id.* ¶ 4 at 8.) Having considered the motion, the record, and the apposite law, I find that the stipulation is proper and should be approved and that this case should be transferred to the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York.

1. That the parties' **Stipulation Re: Agreed Venue of the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York** [#39], filed December 14, 2015, is approved; and

2. That this case is transferred to the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, Manhattan Division (500 Pearl Street, New York, NY 10007-1312).
