It is hereby ORDERED that:

- **Plaintiff's Objection and Motion to Strike Answer Statements by Opposing Counsel (Docket No. 46) is DENIED.** On September 28, 2015 – the deadline ordered by the Court – Defendant timely filed a motion to dismiss in lieu of an answer. (Docket Nos. 22, 24.) Following the Court's resolution of that motion (Docket No. 35), Defendant filed an answer within two weeks (Docket No. 43).
