ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Blackburn, J.

The matter is before me on the **Stipulation for Dismissal of Claims Against Steven Kerbel Without Prejudice** [#15]¹ filed September 24, 2015. After careful review of the stipulation and the file, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that the claims of the plaintiff against defendant, Steven Kerbel, should be dismissed without prejudice. Mr. Kerbel is the last remaining defendant in this case. Thus, I also order that this case be closed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the **Stipulation for Dismissal of Claims Against Steven Kerbel Without Prejudice** is approved;
2. That the claims of the plaintiff against defendant, Steven Kerbel, are

dismissed without prejudice, with the parties to pay their own attorney fees and costs;
