ORDER DISMISSING A PARTY

Blackburn, J.

The matter is before me on the **Stipulation for Dismissal with Prejudice as Against American Family Mutual Insurance Company Only** [#26]¹ filed March 10, 2016. After careful review of the stipulation and the file, I conclude that the stipulation should be approved and that the plaintiff's claims against defendant, American Family Mutual Insurance Company, should be dismissed with prejudice.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. That the **Stipulation for Dismissal with Prejudice as Against American Family Mutual Insurance Company Only** is approved;
2. That plaintiff's claims against defendant, American Family Mutual Insurance Company, are dismissed with prejudice with the parties to pay their own attorney fees
